

But no more. The said United States Court for the
 Western District of the Indian Territory upon the
 due and legal return of her proceedings under the
 order of sale, made as the said party of the first part,
 in Chapter 5th, 907, after making the said sale, made
 an order confirming said sale and directing
 conveyance to be executed to the said party of the second
 part.
 Wherefore, the said Mrs. O. Butler, the guardian of
 said Samuil Butler, James L. Butler and Piers P. Butler
 minors as aforesaid, the party of the first part, pursuant
 to the order last aforesaid, of the said United States
 Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory
 for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen
hundred dollars, to her in hand paid, in the said
 party of the second part, receipt hereof in heretofore
 acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and
 conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Alex. S. Lewis, said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever
 all the right, title, interest and estate of the said
 Samuil Butler, James L. Butler and Piers P. Butler,
 minors in and to the following divided tract of
 land, situate, lying and being in said Cherokee
 Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory
 and particularly described as follows, to-wit:
 The east half of the south-west quarter of the north-west
 quarter, the south-east quarter of the north-west quarter
 of the north-west quarter, the north half of the north-west
 quarter of the north-west quarter of section twenty-
 six (26). The north-west quarter of the north-east quarter
 of the north-west quarter of section twenty-seven
 (27). The south-east quarter of the north-west quarter
