Warranty Deed.

Know all Men By These Presents:  
 That Paul Clinton, an unmarried man  
 and a member of the Tribe of Creek Indians, and of Tulsa  
 County, State of Oklahoma party of the first part, in con-  
 sideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other consider-  
 ations, in hand paid to the said Paul Clinton by  
 Louise Clinton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledg-  
 ed, does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey, into the  
 said Louise Clinton the following described real property  
 and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma to-wit:

The East half of the North-west quarter and the North-  
 east quarter of the South-west quarter of section twenty  
 three (23) township nineteen (19) North, range twelve East,  
 the same being the land selected by the said Paul Clin-  
 ton as a member of said tribe of Indians for an al-  
 lotment exclusive of his homestead, and conveyed to said  
 Paul Clinton by P. Porter, Principal Chief of the said Creek  
 Tribe of Indians by allotment deed dated September 3rd  
 1902, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said above described premises  
 unto the said Louise Clinton, her heirs and assigns for-  
 ever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former  
 grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and  
 other liens and incumbrances of what so ever nature except

One mortgage for \$2400 to J. H. McKinney, now against  
 said land, one agricultural lease now against said  
 land, held by the said J. H. McKinney; one oil and gas min-  
 ing lease to John L. Mitchell on a portion of said land  
 and one oil and gas mining lease to C. R. Howard, J. C.  
 McCreedy and Frank L. Brezfoyle on a portion of said  
 land to all of which said instruments this deed is  
 subject. Signed and delivered this 24th day of December  
 1907.
