 Roser, O. H. Signed and acknowledged this present day of December,  
 That George A. Bayer and, wife, L. P.

Know, his wife, bearing of the first part, and  
 consideration of the sum of Thirty-five thousand  
 (\$35,000) dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is  
 hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, his heirs, sell and  
 convey unto O. H. Roser, the following described  
 real property and premises, situated in the County of  
 Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot fourteen  
 (14) of the Bayer addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,  
 thence south, three hundred (300) feet, thence <sup>thence east two hundred</sup>  
 twenty-six (276) feet,  
 three hundred (300) feet, thence west two hundred  
 eighty-six (276) feet to place of beginning, said property  
 being bounded on the west by Broadwater avenue, on the  
 south by Cedar Street, on the east by Main Street and  
 on the north by lot twelve (12) and fourteen (14) of the Bauer  
 addition to Tulsa, said property being called on the  
 record, lot fifteen, twelve addition, "Oakley"  
 together with the improvements thereon and the  
 appurtenances thereto belonging, and warrant the  
 title to the survivor.
