 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
 conveyed, sold, and conveyed unto the said Theo. J. Clegg
 his heirs and assigns forever, the following described
 lands in the Cherokee Nation and in the Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot No. 360-361 in Block No. 28 of Tulsa Heights, according
 to a map or plat thereof, used by said Tulsa Heights
 Company and filed for record and recorded in the office of
 the Clerk of the United States Court and official Recorder at
 Tulsa, Indian Territory, the same being a part of that
 portion of the West half (W 1/2) of the south-west quarter
 (SW 1/4) and the south-west quarter of the north-west quarter
 (NW 1/4 of SW 1/4) of section No. 24, T. 29 N. R. 24 W.
 (20) North range, Territory (3) West

To have and to hold the same unto the said Theo. J.
 Clegg his heirs and assigns forever, together with all
 the appurtenances therunto in anywise and for the
 consideration aforesaid the said Tulsa Heights Company
 covenant and agree to and with the said Theo. J. Clegg
 his heirs and assigns forever, that it will, lawfully
 warrant and defend the title to the said lands against
