 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
 bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, and conveyed unto the said Theo. J. Cope
 his heirs and assigns forever, the following described
 lands in the Cherokee Nation and in the Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot No. 360-361 in Block No. 28 of Tulsa Heights according
 to a map or plat thereof, as said Tulsa Heights
 Company and said Theo. J. Cope, recorded in the files of
 the Clerk of the United States Court and of the Recorder at
 Tulsa, Indian Territory, the same being a part of that
 portion of the West half (W 1/2) of the south-west quarter
 (SW 1/4) and the south-west quarter of the north-west quarter
 (NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4) of section number (29) Township twenty
 (20) North range thirty (3) West

To have and to hold the same unto the said Theo. J.
 Cope his heirs and assigns forever, together with all
 the appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging, and for the
 consideration aforesaid the said Tulsa Heights Company
 covenants and agrees to and with the said Theo. J. Cope
 his heirs and assigns forever, that it will, lawfully
 warrant and defend the title to the said tract against
