

Warranty Deed.

This instrument, made on the 28th day of November  
A.D. one thousand nine hundred and seven,  
by and between William G. Harvey and Annie  
G. Harvey his wife of the County of Jackson, State of  
Mo., party of the first part, and William H. Cope of the  
County of Jackson, State of Mo., party of the second  
part. Witnesseth, that the said party of the first  
part in consideration of the sum of One dollar and  
exchange of property \$100 dollars to him paid by the said  
party of the second part (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged)  
does by these presents, grant, bargains and sells, convey  
and confirm unto the said party of the second part his  
him and assigns, the following described lots, tract or  
parcel of land lying, being and situate all and all  
situated in the Creek Nation and within the limits  
of the Indian Territory, all of lot twenty-five (25)  
in block number five. In the town of Valley Indian  
Territory as shown by the plat of Valley filed  
with the recorder of Deeds in Wagonee Indian  
Territory. To have and to hold, the premises aforesaid  
with all and singular the rights, privileges,  
appurtenances and immunitiess unto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining unto the said party of the second  
part and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the  
said first party hereby covenanting that he is lawfully  
sized of an indefeasible estate in fee of the premises  
herein conveyed; that he has good right to convey  
the same; that the said premises are free and clear  
from all encumbrances or impediments, by him or those  
whom he dissevered; and that he his heirs and  
assigns will warrant and defend the title to the said  
premises unto the said party of the second part and  
unto her heirs and assigns forever against
