

Quit Claim Deed

The Indians made this 22 day of January in the year one thousand nine hundred eight, (1908) between Eugene Crane and Sarah A. Crane, husband and wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma of the first part and Lillian Plummer, of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Witnesseth, That the said Lillian Plummer, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to her duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, and quitclaim and by these presents do for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators, remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said Lillian Plummer and to her heirs and assigns forever all their right, title, interest, estate they may claim and demand at law and in equity, if in, and to all, & Lots nine (9) ten (10) in Block eleven (11) Burnett addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as it is shown by the record plat and survey thereof. This deed is made to correct the deed made in a former deed made by the same grantor to the same grantee on the 24th day of September A.D. 1907, and filed for record on the 10th day of October A.D. 1907, together with all and singular the covenants and conditions therein contained, to have and to hold the above described premises unto the said Lillian Plummer, her heirs and assigns, so that neither of the said grantor or any person in their name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof, but they and everyone of them shall be taken.
