

Quit Claim Deed.

This Indenture, made this 7th day of March in the year A.D. 1908 between Evaline Grayson of Tulsa County, Oklahoma of the first part, and G. S. Shaver of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar & other good & valuable considerations to me duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in, and to the following described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Section Eighteen (18) Township Nineteen (19) N. & Range Fourteen (14) E. of the Indian Base & Meridian.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
