 paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has-dunned released sold conveyed and quit claimed and by these presents does remise release sell and convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns forever all the right title interest claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvement situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory Western District and known and described as follows to-wit:

Lots twenty-one (21) twenty two (22) twenty-three (23) and twenty-four in Block ^{part of Block} of the town of Broken arrow Indian Territory

To Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the said party of the first part either in law or equity - to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part its successors and assigns forever.
