 granted, sold and conveyed, and by these presents
 does grant, sell and convey unto the said Lewis E.
 Wymouth, all of his undivided one half & interest
 in and to that certain mineral described as lying
 to-wit: The west half of the west half of the south
 west quarter of the north east quarter and the
 east half of the east half of the southeast quarter
 of the northwest quarter of section six, township
 nineteen, north, Range twenty east, containing
 twenty acres, more or less, according to the United
 States survey thereof, said tract of land being
 situate about four miles north of the town of
 Tubac, State of Arizona, in that portion of said
 State of Arizona formerly known as Indian
 Territory.
 To have and to hold the above described premises,
 together with all and singular the rights and
 appurtenances thereto in anywise relating to the
 said Lewis E. Wymouth, her heirs and assigns
 forever.
