W 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township eighteen (18) north Range thirteen (13) east, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging. To Have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said party of the second-part her heirs and assigns forever.
