

Quit-Claim Deed

This Indenture made this 4th day of November in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven (1907) between Eva May Neal and Charles E. Neal her husband of Baldwin in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Mary Alice Welch of the second part. Witnesseth: that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred twenty five (\$625⁰⁰) Dollars to them duly paid, have sold, and by these presents do release, and Quit-claim unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcels of land, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma and described as follows to-wit: Undivided one-half interest in east half of southeast quarter of north east-quarter section twenty-two (22) and the west half of south west quarter of north west quarter of section twenty three (23) in township twenty of range thirteen (13); also the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section twenty-two (22) in township twenty (20) of Range thirteen (13) with all the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises, together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever.
