

Quit Claim Deed.

This Indenture, made the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1908 between William Sims and Mable C. Sims, both unmarried, of Montgomery County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and George A. Skinner of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and  $\frac{1}{100}$  dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, remise, release and quit claim unto said Party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Lot two (2) in Block one hundred and ninety three (193) in the City of Tulsa as shown by the recorded plat thereof. To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise pertaining forever.
