To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, a townsite commission, heretofore appointed and
 acting under authority of the act of Congress approved March
 1, 1901 (31 Stat. 861), agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May
 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of Tulsa, Mus-
 kogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory; and

Whereas, the plat of said town was approved by the
 Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day of April, 1902, and
 was duly placed on file; and,

Whereas, said commission has appraised all of
 the town lots included in said plat at their true value,
 excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approv-
 ed by the Secretary of the Interior; and,
