

Five degrees forty six minutes west ($85^{\circ}46'W$) seven hundred fifty feet (750') north to a dead end in section ten (10), township seventeen (17) north of range twelve (12) east, each of said lines consisting of four (4) pipes, being of the total length of two thousand two hundred thirty five feet (2,235'); and there is hereby granted the right to erect and maintain a telephone and telegraph line. The rights herein granted shall permit the use of such land as may be necessary for said pipe line, or said telephone and telegraph line, and shall also permit the grantee herein, its successors and assigns, to do whatever may be necessary to their construction, or for the enjoyment of the rights herein granted, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said tract of land for the purpose of laying, maintaining, repairing and restoring said pipe lines and said telephone and telegraph lines, and for removing the same when desired by the grantee, its successors and assigns.

To Have and To Hold the said easement unto the said Gulf Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns, so long as the same shall be useful for the purpose desired by said grantee;
