To Cyrus S. Avery. This Indenture made and entered into this the 2nd day of March, 1908, by and between William H. Ford, as guardian of Virgin Mary Ford, Mary Magdalena Ford, William M. Kinley Ford, Jackson Ford and Willie Ford, minors, of Muskogee County, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Cyrus S. Avery, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part;

Witnesseth: That whereas, on the 13th day of January, 1908, the Honorable W. C. Jackson, Judge of the County Court of Muskogee County, Oklahoma, made and entered an order authorizing the party of the first part to make sale of the interests of the said Virgin Mary Ford, Mary Magdalena Ford, William M. Kinley Ford, Jackson Ford and Willie Ford, minors, in and to the land herein after described, having first given the time and place of such sale by posting in three of the most public places in the country in which the land is situated and by publishing certain notices in a newspaper of said county for a period of three weeks successively next before the date of said sale, and
