 into this, the 10th day of April
 1918 by and between Lon Lewis, as Sheriff of
 Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the
 first part and C. H. Cleveland, party of the second
 part.

Witnesseth that

Whereas on the 11th day of October, 1907 in a
 certain cause pending in the United States Court
 within and for the western District of
 the Indian Territory, sitting at Tulsa, wherein
 George M. Janeway was plaintiff and Minnie
 E. Sunday and R. F. Sunday were defendants, the
 plaintiff George M. Janeway recovered judgment
 against Minnie E. Sunday and R. F. Sunday
 in the sum of Four hundred Eighteen and $\frac{32}{100}$
 (418 $\frac{32}{100}$) dollars, together with the costs of
 said proceedings and.

Whereas, in said cause judgment
 was rendered in favor of the said George
 M. Janeway and against the said Minnie E.
 Sunday and R. F. Sunday foreclosing a certain
 deed of mortgage on Lot four (4) in Block
 twenty-three (23) of the town of Skiatook Tulsa
 County Oklahoma and decreeing the judg-
 ment for said Four hundred Eighteen and
 $\frac{32}{100}$ (418.32) dollars and costs to be a lien on
 said lot four (4) in said block twenty-three
 (23) in said town of Skiatook and ordering
 and decreeing a sale of said lot for the
 satisfaction of said judgment unless the
 said Minnie E. Sunday and R. F. Sunday within
 thirty (30) days from the date of said judgment
 should pay and discharge the same and
 ordering that if said judgment was not
 paid and discharged within said thirty
 (30) days from the date thereof that the said
 Minnie E. Sunday and R. F. Sunday
 should be forever barred and foreclosed
 of any and all interest in and to said lot
