Whereas, the said Jimmie C. Sunday and R. F. Sunday wholly failed and neglected to pay said judgment within the thirty (30) days fixed in said order and decree and, Whereas, on the 22nd day of November 1907, said cause came on to be heard by the district court of Tulsa County Oklahoma on the motion of the plaintiff in said cause for an order directing the clerk of said court to issue an order of sale to the sheriff of Tulsa County for the sale of said lot four (4) in Block twenty three (23) in said town of Skiatook for the satisfaction of a judgment theretofore rendered in said cause and Whereas the district court of said Tulsa County on said day found said judgment, so rendered by the said United States Court unpaid and that said judgment was in full force and effect and adopted, ratified and affirmed said judgment of said United States Court and made the same the judgment of the district court of Tulsa County Oklahoma, in said cause and directed the clerk of said court to issue an order of sale
