

conveyance (12), and the right to (13),
 shall permit the use of such land as may be necessary for said pipe line as
 herein granted, shall permit the grantee
 herein its successors and assigns to do
 whatever may be necessary to their construct-
 ion or for the enjoyment of the rights herein
 granted including the right of ingress and
 egress to and from said tract of land for
 the purpose of laying maintaining repairing
 and restoring of said pipe line and for
 removing of same when desired by the
 grantee its successors and assigns.

To Have and to hold the said ease-
 ment unto the said Gulf Pipe Line Com-
 pany its successors and assigns so long
 as the same shall be useful for the
 purpose desired, of by the said grantee
 which by the acceptance hereby covenants
 and agrees with the grantor that the
 pipe line shall be buried so as not to
 interfere with the cultivation of the same.

It is understood that the person
 signing this right of way for said
 company is without authority to make
 any agreement, covenant or promise in
 its behalf not herein specifically shown
 and this instrument is delivered and ac-
 cepted upon the distinct understanding that
 the consideration hereinabove stated is the
 sole consideration and inducement therefor.
