

and restoring of said pipe line and for removing of same when desired by the grantee its successors and assigns. To have and to hold the said easement unto the said Gulf pipe line company its successors and assigns so long as the same shall be useful for the purpose desired of by said grantee which by the acceptance hereof covenants and agrees with the grantor that the pipe line shall be buried so as not to interfere with the cultivation of the same.

It is understood that the person securing this right of way for said company is without authority to make any agreement covenant or promise in its behalf not herein specifically shown and this instrument is delivered and accepted upon the distinct understanding that the consideration hereinabove stated is the sole consideration and inducement therefor
