

Option Deed.

For and in consideration of the sum of \$100.00 to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed and the undertaking of E. A. Crewson, to pay to me Wallie Bell Franklin, the only heir of R. E. Franklin deceased, the sum of six hundred dollars on or before the first day of May 1909 hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. A. Crewson and to her heirs, successors, assigns upon the conditions herein after written, the following described land situated in Tulsa County and state of Oklahoma, to wit: all of the south west quarter of section nine, Township nineteen north and range ten east. If said E. A. Crewson, shall fail to pay the sum herein before named within the time above set forth, this conveyance shall be void, and all rights and liabilities of either party thereunder shall cease, and said land shall revert to Wallie Bell Franklin, said Wallie Bell Franklin poor and in consideration of the above agreement represent that she is the mother of said R. E. Franklin, deceased, that said land has been allotted to said R. E. Franklin as a Creek citizen and is enrolled as a Freedman on the rolls of the Dawes Commission, and that she as the sole heir of said R. E. Franklin deceased has a good right to sell the same.
