Order Of Confirmation.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on this 4th day of May, 1908, that on the 15th day of April, 1908, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described; and.

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 15th day of April, 1908, the Court made an order setting the 4th day of May, 1908, for the hearing of said petition, and in said order required the publication of notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 4th day of May, 1908; and.

It further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December, 1907, the executrix, Emily M. Campbell, the petitioner aforementioned, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent as to her seemed fit and proper; and.

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will, the said executrix, Emily M. Campbell, sold to R. W. Kellough, Lots One (1), Two (2), and Three (3) in Block Two (2) of the George Herriman Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of \$2170.00; and.

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent, and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted; that the sum paid was more than 90% of the
