then undertakes, made, this 4th day of May, A. D. 1908, between J. A. Friend, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, the duly appointed and qualified guardian of John Howard Allen and Sam Shoben, minors, under letter issued from the County Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, as such guardian, party of the first part, and A. F.ault and Charles Page of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, as parties of the second part: Witness.

That, whereas, the said party of the first part as such guardian, on the 9th, day of March, A. D. 1908, filed his petition in said County Court praying upon legal cause therein set forth for an order to sell the real estate belonging to said wards, having after advised, and gave notice of such application, to all persons concerned, by publication in the Tulsa Weekly Oklawaha, a newspaper published in said County of Tulsa, once a week for three consecutive weeks of the hearing of said petition. And whereas, the said County Court after hearing said application, on the 11th, day of April, A. D. 1908, and by order duly entered, empowered and directed the said J. A. Friend as such guardian, to sell as public sale, the real estate of said wards having after advised, as prayed in said petition.
