

Quit Claim deed.
With relinquishment of Dower.

This Indenture, made this 7th day of May, A.D. 1908
between Tom Vinell, Sam Vinell, John Vinell, Lizzie
Gilcrease and Maggie Withers and Rena Hamwell of Wound,
Oklahoma - parties of the first part, and Robert F.
Gruell of Agency, Missouri, - party of the second part
Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part,
for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars,
- in hand paid by the said party of the second part
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have devised,
released, sold, conveyed and quitclaimed, and by
these presents, do devise, release, sell and convey and
quit claim unto the said party of the second part
his heirs and assigns forever, all the right title,
interest, claim and demand which said parties of
the first part have in and to the following described
lot, piece or parcel of land or improvement situated
in the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma and known and
described as follows, to wit:

The southeast quarter of section (20) twenty-six, township
(17) seventeen north, range (12) twelve east of the Indian
Base and Meridian, according to the Government survey
thereof, containing one hundred and sixty acres,
more or less, and being the allotment of Longy Ethel
Withers, now deceased.
