

This Indenture, made and entered into this 21st day of September A.D. 1907, by and between Adelta Berry, of Tulsa I. T. party of the first part, and the St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1), to her in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, convey and warrant unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate, to-wit:

A strip of land fifty (50) feet wide, situated in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section eight (8), township nineteen (19), north, range twelve (12) east, Creek Nation Indian Territory, said strip of land being twenty five (25) feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of main track of the Arkansas Valley & Western Railway Company with the west line of section (9) nine, said point of intersection is six hundred thirty seven and $\frac{5}{10}$ (637.5) feet north, measured along said west line of section nine (9), from the southwest corner of said section nine (9); thence in a westerly direction along center line of main track aforesaid, and making an angle of eighty eight (88) degrees and twenty (20) minutes, with aforesaid west line of section nine (9), a distance of thirty two hundred and five (3205) feet, for a point of beginning; thence in a westerly direction on a curve to the right, the radius of which is seven hundred

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
