Having and excepting herefrom, all right of way hereto just acquired by the party of the second part.

To have and to hold the above described premises unto the said St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, as and for a railroad right of way, and for all purposes incidental to or connected with the maintenance and operation of a railroad; and whenever abandoned for said purpose, the said Premises shall revert to the Grantor herein her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
