

7 To Have and To Hold the same unto the Railroad Company, and unto it and its successors and assigns forever, so that neither the party of the first part nor anyone for her or them, or any one claiming through or under her or them, shall or will hereafter make any claim to said property, or to or for any further compensation for said right of way, or said land taken, or for any damage done or to be done by the construction of the railroad of the Railway Company, or by the taking of said lands for Railroad purposes, but said party of the first part and all claiming by, through or under her or them, and they and every of them, shall by these presents, be forever barred.
