This instrument, made this 27th day of May, nineteen hundred and eighty and between S. W. Lewis, and Elizabeth S. Lewis, his wife, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, having thereto called the party of the first part, and R. E. Holman & Son of Winsted, Connecticut, having after called the party of the second part, witnesseth:

That whereas, the said party of the first part is jointly indebted unto the said party of the second part in the sum of fifty hundred dollars, as is evidenced by two principal notes of even date herewith, bearing due as follows, to-wit:

One note for three hundred dollars, due January 1, 1913.
 One note for three hundred dollars, due January 1, 1913.
 One note for three hundred dollars, due January 1, 1913.
 with interest at the rate of six percent, per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of June and December in each year, as specified by instructions: said notes drawn in trust at the rate of eight per cent. per annum after maturity, and are payable to said second party, or at the order of National Bank of Winsted, Connecticut, in U. S. gold coin of present standard weight and fineness.

Now, therefore, the said first party, in consideration of the promise and for the purpose of securing the indebtedness aforesaid, does hereby grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said second party this land, and assigns, forever, the following described lands and premises, situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: the south half of section twenty of township one north and the northeast quarter of section twenty of T. one north and the south west
