

## Quit Claim Dede.

This Indenture made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1908, between Patrick Fitzgerald and Ella Fitzgerald, his wife, of Birby, Okla. Tulsa County, of the first part, and J. G. Painter, of Birby, Oklahoma, Party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said parties, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty ~~four~~<sup>one</sup> (\$50 ~~00~~<sup>00</sup>) Dollars, in hand paid by the said Party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have remised, released sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents do remise, release sell and convey and quit claim unto the said Party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest claim and demand which said parties of the first part have in and to the following described lot, piece, or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Incorporated Town of Birby, Oklahoma and known and described as follows, to wit: All of Lot six (6) in Block twenty seven (27) of the original townsite of said town according to U.S. Govt. Survey and Plat of said Townsite.

To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatsoever of the said Painter, of the first party, either in law or equity, to the only purchase, benefit and behoy of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
