Know all men by these presents, that S. R. M. Ellough, Trustee, of the County of Tucker, State of Oklahoma, part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of eleven hundred and no/100 dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Elmer R. Kelly, party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, the following described real property and premises, situated in Tucker County, State of Oklahoma to wit:

All of Lot three (3) of Block two (2) of Kirkwood Place, in addition to the site of Tucker, together with all

the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belonging and warrant the title to the same, to have and to hold said divided premises unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and incumbrances whatsoever.
