Witnesseth That the said parties of the first

 claimed, and by these presents do for themselves, their

 lease, and forever quit claim unto the said party
 of the second part and to his heirs and assigns
 forever, all their right, title, interest, estate,
 claim and demand both at law and in equity
 to, in and to all the following property situated
 in the City of Tulsa in the Indian Territory, to wit:
 an undivided one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) interest in Lots
 One (1) and Two (2) in Block Ninety (90) ac-
 cording to the recorded plat thereof.

To have with all and singular hereditaments
 and appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging. To have and
 to hold the above described premises unto the said
 S. Thornton his heirs and assigns, so that neither
 the said E. M. Robinson nor Cora C. Robinson or
 any person in their name and behalf shall or just
 hereafter claim or demand any right or title
 to the said premises or any part thereof; but
 they and every one of them shall by these presents
 be excluded and forever barred and their heirs
 Cora C. Robinson waive all claim to do so, now
 made and all and every other interest, actual or
