redemption, have fully conveyed, granted, sold and agreed
to and with the said party of the second part, that at the
delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in fee

simple, if an absolute and independent estate of
possession, in fee simple, if in and to all and
singular the above granted and described premises,
with the appurtenances, that the same are free, clear
unincumbered and unincumbered of and from all former
