

Dashedale, A. Castella } General Warranty Deed
 to
 Matt. Castella } This Indenture, Made this 9th day of
 and Mary Bonkdale } December A.D. 1907 between A. C. Birkdale
 his wife, and George West a widower, of Tulsa, in Tulsa
 County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part and
 Castella Matt. of the second part.

It is covenanted, The said parties of the first part, in consideration
 of the sum of Two thousand and no dollars, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents
 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the
 second part her heirs and assigns, all of the following
 described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma; to wit:

The west fifty (50) feet of lot numbered six (6) in
 Block numbered Fifty-three (53) except that portion of
 said lot taken by the M. & T. R. R. Co. right of way in
 the City of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, according to the
 approved plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and
 singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said grantors, for themselves and their heirs, executors
 or administrators do hereby covenant, promise and agree
 to and with the said party of the second part, that at the
 delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their
 own right of a certain lot and undivided estate of an
 inheritance in fee simple, of and in and singular
 the above granted and described premises with the
 appurtenances that the same are free clear, discharged
 and unincumbered of and from all taxes and other
 public, title charges, estate, judgments, taxes, assessments
 and incumbrances of what nature or kind whatsoever.
