

Maxiner Henry P. { General Warranty Deed
 to Rosa Lunberg { This Indenture made this 13th day of
 December A.D. 1907 between Henry P. Maxiner
 a single man of the Township of Riana in the County of
 Hersey in the State of Illinois, party of the first part and
 Rosa Lunberg of Brighton, Macoupin County Illinois, party
 of the second part Witnesseth. The said party of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain,
 sell and convey unto the said party of the second part her
 heirs and assigns all the following described real estate
 situated in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory to wit:
 All of lot seven (7) in Block fifty (50) of West Tula Addition
 a subdivision of the east half of the Northwest quarter of
 section fourteen (14) Township nineteen (19) North Range
 twelve (12) east according to the amended plat thereof
 recorded in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States
 Court & Ex-Officio Recorder of Tulsa, Indian Territory, in
 Book two (2) at page 639. To have and to hold the same
 together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
 any way appertaining forever. And said party of the first
 part for himself, his heirs, executors or administrators, does
 hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second
 part that he will warrant and forever defend the title
 to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs
 and assigns against all and every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming the same.
