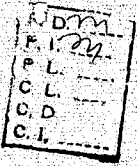

Deed of Release.

The Tulsa Modern Woodmen Building Association,
Know All Men By These Presents: That C. W. Smith for and in the consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars, to me paid by the Tulsa Modern Woodmen Building Association, a corporation do hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said The Tulsa Modern Woodmen Building Association, a corporation and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the 25th Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The South 41 feet of Lot 2 in Block 91 in the Town of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain Real Estate Mortgage dated April 7, 1906 and recorded April 11, 1906 in Book 13 at Page 248, of the records of the 25th Recording District of the Indian Territory, by the Tulsa Modern Woodmen Building Association, a corporation conveying said real estate to C. W. Smith to secure the payment of one certain promissory note herein named, the same having been fully paid.
