Agricultural Lease.

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Jennie Blum of Tulsa a Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred & 00/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid by W. Thornburgh of Okmulgee the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further payments to be made as follows, to wit: None have demise and leased and do hereby demise, lease and farm let to the said W. Thornburgh for the period of five (5) years from the 1st day of Jan 1902 for agricultural purposes, the following described lands and premises, to wit: The N¹/₄ of S¹/₄ of S 7-T 19N-R 13E and the E¹/₂ of S W¹/₄ of S¹/₄ S 17-T 18N-R 13 E of the Indian Base and Meridian in the Indian Territory, containing 160 acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof.

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid lands and premises unto the said W. Thornburgh his heirs and assigns for the period and term aforesaid, and I hereby covenant to and with the said W. Thornburgh that I am lawfully seized of the said lands and premises and have good right to lease the same to the said W. Thornburgh, and that I, my heirs, executors ^{and administrators} shall warrant and defend the possession of the said lands and premises to the said W. Thornburgh for the period and term aforesaid.
