Smith of Tulsa, Indian Territory, all their right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever it may have acquired in, through only a certain mortgage, bearing date } November 20th, 1905 { and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court for the } Northern { District of the Indian Territory, at Claremore in Book } 37 { at Page } 238 { to the premises herein described, as follows: Part of Lots Numbered Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Number Five (5) in the Town of North Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, described as, all that part of Lot Number Two (2) which lies south of a line which is parallel to and forty (40) feet distance from the South line of said Lot Number Two (2) and also that part of Lot Number Three (3) which lies North of a line which is parallel to and twenty five (25) feet and nine (9) inches South of the North line of Lot Three (3). All in said Block Five (5) in the Town of North Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and all improvements thereon, together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
