Hire's Deed.

W. A. Graham,

I now affy Me by These Presents, that John L. Thompson, of Silina, I. T., party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars to him in hand paid by W. A. Graham, of Ryan Creek, I. T., party of the second, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has this day granted, bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part certain lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Cherokee Nation,
Town Recording District, Indian Territory, to wit: An undivided one eighteenth ($\frac{1}{18}$) interest in and the northeast quarter
($NE \frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($NE \frac{1}{4} \frac{1}{4}$); the north half ($N \frac{1}{2}$) of the south quarter ($SE \frac{1}{4} \frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($NE \frac{1}{4}$), and the northwest
quarter ($NW \frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter ($NW \frac{1}{4} \frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($NE \frac{1}{4}$), section thirty, township 23, north, range 14, east of the
Silina Meridian, containing seventy acres more or less, and being the allotment of Nancy Deal, deceased.

To Have and to Hold unto the said W. A. Graham, his heirs and assigns forever, together with all and singular the rights,
affumances and immunitate thence belonging. And the said party of the first part covenants with the said party of the
second part, his heirs and assigns that the aforesaid Nancy Deal is now deceased, leaving, surviving her as sole and
only heir, Nathaniel H. Deal, his son, Rebecca Loftin a daughter and the children of Ammy Thompson, or Ammy
Catherine Thompson, deceased, who was a daughter of said Nancy Deal, the children of the said Ammy or Ammy
Catherine Thompson being Arthur Blair, Martha J. Blackwood, John L. Thompson, Ollie Thompson, Nathaniel
Thompson and Earl Thompson; and that the said party of the first part is John L. Thompson, son of the aforesaid Ammy
Catherine Thompson, deceased, and the owner of an undivided one eighteenth ($\frac{1}{18}$) interest in and to the lands aforesaid
aforesaid, that said lands are free of incumbrances, and that he will and his heirs, administrators and executors
shall warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claimants. And further that first party is unmoved from
the witness whereof the said John L. Thompson has hereunto set his hand and seal the 30th day of June, 1908.
