Deed of Release.

Know all Men By These Presents:

That I, John Washburn, for and in the consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to me paid by Antinette Johnson do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Antinette Johnson and unto her heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate lying in the 25th Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit: All of Lots Six (6) and Seven (7) in Block Seven (7) in the Town of North Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the plat as approved by the Secretary of the Interior.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated June 20, 1905 and recorded June 22, 1905 in Book 11, at Page 18, of the records of the 4th Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Antinette Johnson conveying said real estate to John Washburn to secure the payment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
