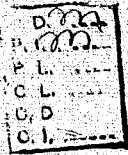

Release of Mortgage

Know all Men By These Presents, that, Whereas, on the 6 day of Feb. A. D. 1906 a mortgage was executed by Lee Short and Mary Short to A. J. Welch for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to-wit:

The South half of the North east quarter of Section Eight in Township Twenty North and Range Thirteen East of the Indiana Base and Meridian in Ind. Ter. said mortgage having been filed for record on 12 day of Feb. A. D. 1906 and recorded in vol. 5, at page 346, in the office of the J. L. Spangler Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio recorder at Wagoner, Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of notes for \$1025.00 and \$500.00 and whereof said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full.

Now, in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to me in hand paid by said Lee Short and Mary Short the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claim and set over, and by these presents hereby grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said Lee Short and Mary Short their heirs and assigns all my right title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Lee Short and Mary Short their heirs and assigns, unto their proper use, benefit and behoof; forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all liens and claims under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
