Kirkpatrick, of Illinois, Indian Territory, the following described personal property located and being upon the following described lands, situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory to-wit: a part of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twelve (12) East, same being the lease granted to the Cherokee Pressed Brick and Tile Company; said personal property being described as follows to-wit:
