Morrison and Mary Morrison, his wife of Rixby, Indian Territory who, after being duly sworn, upon their oaths state that they are of legal age and Creek Indians of one half blood that they are the father and mother of Bessie Morrison, deceased whose allotment was described as follows: The SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and Lot two (2) of Sec. 6, Township Eighteen (18) North and Range fourteen (14) East and NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 18 N. R. 14 E. and SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 18 N. R. 14 E. containing 160 acres of land in Creek Nation, Indian Territory. Said Bessie Morrison died in the year June 1899 at the age of 8 months of age without issue and intestate.
