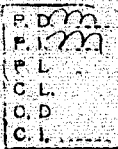

Know all Men By these Presents: That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa, Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of full payment, does hereby release and forever discharge the certain mortgages executed by Hattie Simpson and Peter Simpson to the Union Trust Company dated the 20th day of ^{11th} April 1906, and recorded in Book 14 of page 141 of the records of mortgages at Sapulpa, Ind. Ter., covering the following described property to wit: Northwest 1/4 (10) acres of Lot Three (3) of Section Three (3) Township Nineteen (19), Range Twelve (12) East.

This release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article III of the by laws of said Company as follows:
