Deed.

This Indenture, made and entered into this, the 5th day of November, 1906, by and between Mahaley Ward, wife of Alonzo Ward, party of the first part, and Frank A. Gillespie, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: that for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, and other valuable considerations, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, confirm, release and quiet claim all my right, title, interest and estate in and to the following described real estate, to wit: The north west quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section Thirty three (33), Township Twenty four (24), Range Thirteen (13) East, lying, being and situate in the Cherokee Nation, in the Indian Territory together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging in any wise appertaining, to have and to hold unto him, the said Frank A. Gillespie, and his heirs and assigns, in fee simple absolute forever.
