Gillette, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents hereby sell, transfer, convey and forever quit claim unto the said C. W. Bliss and J. M. Gillette, all of our right title and interest in and to the following described land to-wit:—

The North-West 1/4 of North-West 1/4 of North-West 1/4 Section Twelve (12), Township 19, North Range 12 East, in Creek Nation Indian Territory.

To have and to hold unto the said C. W. Bliss and J. M. Gillette their heirs and assigns forever,

And I, Mary L. Lewis, wife of the said L. L. Lewis, for and in consideration aforesaid do hereby convey, release, relinquish and renounce forever, all of my right, claim and possibility of dower and Homestead in and to said property aforesaid.
