Brady the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claim and set over and by these presents do hereby grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said A. C. Brady his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property together with all the covenants and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said A. C. Brady his heirs and assigns, and to their proper use, benefit and behoof; forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all lien and claim and encumbrance by virtue of the mortgage of premises so testifying whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20 day of November A.D. 1906.
