Andrew Wiley of lawful age being first duly sworn upon his oath deposes and says: that he is a Creek Indian, Roll No. 1473 and that he and his daughter, Susie Wiley (or Barnett), who is a Creek Indian, Roll No. 1475 are the identical persons who, in the year 1905, made application to the United States Indian Agent for removal of restrictions upon the sale of their allotments in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory and the identical persons whose restrictions upon the alienation or leasing of lands held by them were removed by the Act of Congress, approved June 21, 1906, being public No. 258.

Affiant further states that his former wife Millie Wiley who died on the 3rd day of April, 1890 was the mother of the above named Susie Wiley (or Barnett) and was a sister of Ben Island, who was a Creek Indian, Roll No. 5395; that said Ben Island is now deceased; that at the time of his death he left neither father, mother, brother nor sister, nor wife nor living descendants of either, nor any other heirs except his said sister, the said Millie Wiley, and two children of Ben Island's deceased wife, Mary Island, which said children died, unmarried and without issue; that said Susie Wiley (or Barnett) is the widow of George Barnett, now deceased, and has never been married since the death of her said husband.
