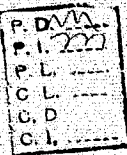

to

Quit Claim Deed

John H. Rhynes,

This Indenture, made this 26 day of November A.D. 1906 between Samuel W. Orcutt and — of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and — and John H. Rhynes of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory, Western District, party of the second part,

Witnesseth: that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one and no/100 dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has unincumbered, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents, does devise, release, sell and convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to wit: Lots numbers, 19-20-21-22-23 and 24 all in Block Number 46, in the town of Broken Arrow Indian Territory

and I Sarah J. Orcutt wife of the said Samuel W. Orcutt, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part — of the first part either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part — his heirs and assigns forever.

In Witness Whereof, We the said Samuel W. Orcutt and Sarah J. Orcutt hereunto set our hands and seals this 26th day of Nov. A.D. 1906.
