Ordinance No. 159.

An Ordinance amendatory to Ordinance No. 103, entitled, "An Ordinance providing for the vacation of the alley running through block 201, from East to West, and opening up and establishing in lieu thereof an alley in said block running North and South". Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory:

- Section 1: - That Ordinance No. 103 be, and the same is hereby repealed.
- Section 2: - That the alley running through Block No. 201 from East to West be and the same is hereby vacated.
- Section 3: - The property owners of block No. 201, within the limits of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the plat thereof as approved by the Council of the Interior, April 11, 1902, are hereby authorized to change the alley running through the said block from East to West and to open in lieu thereof an alley to run through said block from North to South, 20 feet in width.
- Section 4: - That the said property owners are hereby authorized to file a plat showing the change of the original survey of the said block to that of the present survey thereof with alley running through said block from North to South as hereby authorized, and the closing up of the present alley running East and West.
- Section 5: - All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 6: - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

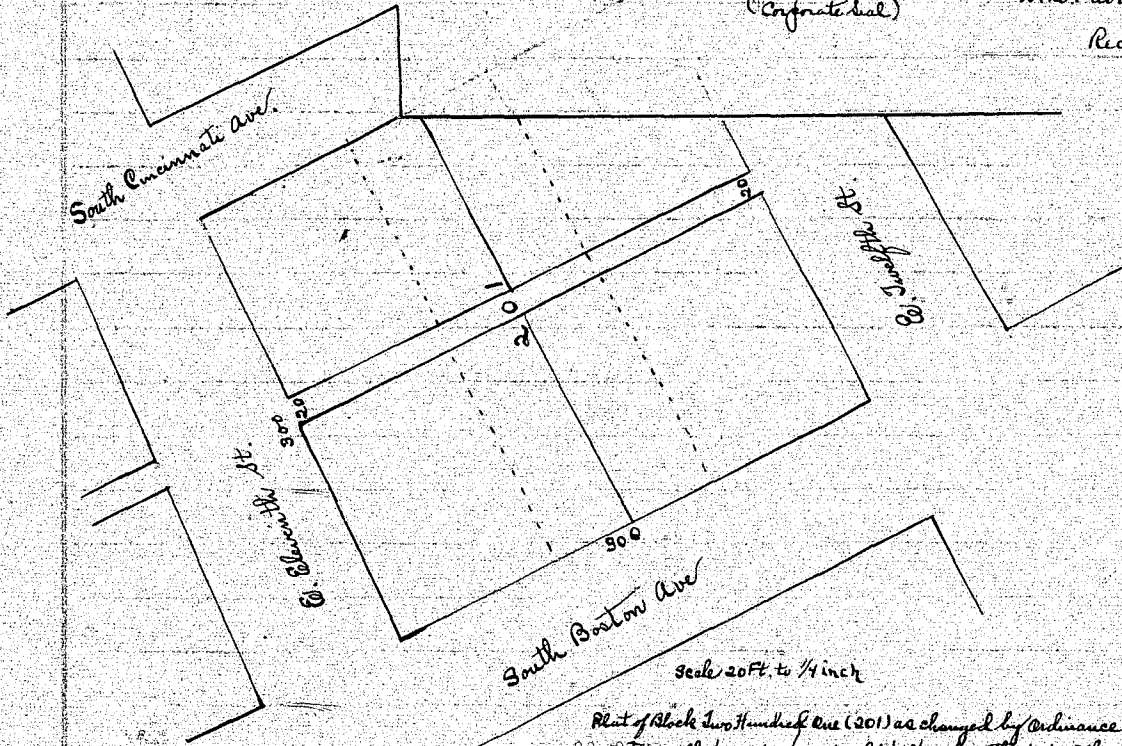
