Also the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 36, Twp. 21 N, Range 12 East.

She further states that there were five children born to her and her husband, Lewis C. Candrey, namely; Lizzie Sombe, nee Candrey age 28 Mary Willeabout nee Candrey age 23 Jennette Candrey age 18 Emma Candrey age 11 Belle Candrey age 8 -- these were the sole and only children born of their marriage that are now living.

There were five other children born to this marriage all of whom are now dead and died without any living issue.
